## Usage & Care Instructions

## Setting Up in Cold Weather

- If you're using the tub in a cold environment, soak it in warm water for 2–3 minutes before use.
- This helps the material become more flexible.

## Cleaning the Tub

- · Use warm water only to clean the tub.
- Do not use detergents or cleaning agents, as they may damage the material.

## Filling the Tub

- Use water with a temperature no higher than 50°C (122°F).
- Fill the tub to your desired level, but do not exceed two-thirds of its total height.

#### Before First-Time Use

- A slight plastic smell may be noticeable at first this is normal and will fade over time.
- The tub is made from safe, non-toxic materials and is completely safe to use.

## Extreme Temperature Guidelines

## In Extreme Cold (below -40°C / -40°F):

- Drain all water from the tub.
- Store the tub indoors to prevent material damage from freezing water.

## In Extreme Heat (above 40°C / 104°F):

- Avoid leaving the tub in direct sunlight for long periods.
- UV rays can cause the material to weaken or degrade over time.








Open up the package and lay the deflated tub on a flat surface
