

# FIFR PLUNGE TUB MAX

## Usage & Care Instructions

### Setting Up in Cold Weather

- If you're using the tub in a cold environment, soak it in warm water for 2-3 minutes before use.
- This helps the material become more flexible.

### Cleaning the Tub

- Use warm water only to clean the tub.
- Do not use detergents or cleaning agents, as they may damage the material.

### Filling the Tub

- Use water with a temperature no higher than 50°C (122°F).
- Fill the tub to your desired level, but do not exceed two-thirds of its total height.

### Before First-Time Use

- A slight plastic smell may be noticeable at first—this is normal and will fade over time.
- The tub is made from safe, non-toxic materials and is completely safe to use.

## Extreme Temperature Guidelines

### In Extreme Cold (below -40°C / -40°F):

- Drain all water from the tub.
- Store the tub **indoors** to prevent material damage from freezing water.

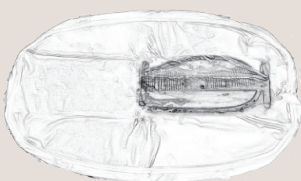


### In Extreme Heat (above 40°C / 104°F):

- Avoid leaving the tub in **direct sunlight** for long periods.
- UV rays can cause the material to **weaken or degrade** over time.

Open up the package and lay the deflated tub on a flat surface

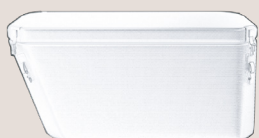
Pop the air inlet / outlet up

03



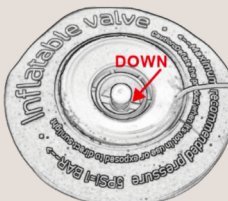
Insert the air pump nozzle and inflate the tub

STEP  
04



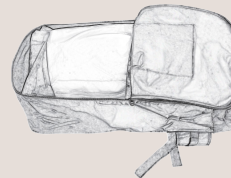
Your tub is now set up

STEP

To deflate, press the air inlet / outlet down & allow air to escape

STEP

Fold the deflated tub and store in the bag cover

**WARNING!**

**ONLY PUMP THE TUB TO A PRESSURE OF 4-6 PSI. ANY MORE THAN THIS MAY CAUSE DAMAGE TO THE TUB.**
