Setting Up in Cold Weather

- If you're using the tub in a cold environment, soak it in warm water for 2-3 minutes before use.
- This helps the material become more flexible.

Cleaning the Tub

- · Use warm water only to clean the tub.
- · Do not use detergents or cleaning agents, as they may damage the material.
- Use water with a temperature no higher than 50°C (122°F).
- · Fill the tub to your desired level, but do not exceed two-thirds of its total height.

- · A slight plastic smell may be noticeable at first—this is normal and will fade over time.
- · The tub is made from safe, non-toxic materials and is completely safe to use.


